- 3) Come to John Bapst High School between 1- 2:30 p.m. that day to decorate your table according to the book's theme.
- 4) Paper & plastic products (table cloths, plates, cups, napkins) are provided. You can certainly bring your own. Bringing you own tea cups & tea pots is encouraged.
- 5) All other materials and equipment are the Designer's responsibility.
- 6) Provide a theme-based favor for each person at your table.
- 7) No charge to enter a table; as the designer, your ticket is FREE.
- 8) Share with your friends! They can buy seats at your table.

During the tea party, attendees will also enjoy refreshments, viewing other tables, and a reading from Maine children's author.
